

I think the reason there are so many unindentified vehicles is when a new film gets entered it quickly gets pushed down on the last completed movies list when new films are added, and it isn't too long before it drops off the list altogether and the film gets forgotten about before everything is identified. There's some vehicles I've added that I don't think are impossible to identify, it's just no one here recognizes them yet, particularly vintage cars. I think if something has at least a 2-star rating (which it is somewhat used in the action) it deserves indentifying unless the visibility is so poor that idenification is nearly impossible.

There's nearly always a chance that something can be identified, in Clerks I entered the ambulance that takes Caitlin away (after she has sex with the dead guy in the toilet), only the back could be seen and box-style American ambulances you need to see the cab, but someone found the website for the paramedics group that used the ambulance and found out what it was from there.
